Other Costs

Additional costs are charged to the school account for incidental items such as co-curricular activities, including music tuition and examination fees (NCEA, Pitmans, IELTS etc). These costs are communicated to families before being charged to a school account.

Kristin Education Bond

This will provide adequate time for the issue of Student Visas by the New Zealand Immigration Service. Student Visas issued specifically for Kristin School must be presented to the Admissions Manager before International Students can participate in any Kristin programme including but not limited to orientation, camp preparation, sports and cultural sessions and course commencement.

The package fee quoted is applicable to students for up to one year's (four terms) enrolment only. If a student wishes to re-enrol for any additional time at Kristin School, standard International Student fees will apply.

Tuition Fee Protection

The Board has in place a policy, which holds all pre-paid tuition fees in a reserve. At the beginning of each term, a quarter of the pre-paid tuition fees is transferred from the reserve to the school's income account. This policy enables the pre-paid portion of the fees to be readily identified at any time.

Health and Travel Insurance

International/foreign fee-paying students are not entitled to publicly funded health services while in New Zealand. Therefore, if you receive medical treatment during your visit, you will be liable for the full costs of that treatment. It is the policy of Kristin School that all international students have insurance to cover the cost of any medical treatment for the duration of their stay in New Zealand. Your insurance must also cover your travel to and from New Zealand. International students who are offered a place at Kristin School for a definite period of time must also hold Medical and Travel Insurance with a Ministry of Education approved insurer. "Uni-Care" is the insurance policy recommended by Kristin School.

All amounts include GST.
